

DIRECTIONS TO CAMP WO-ME-TO

From Baltimore and South

I-95 North to Exit 77B, Route 24 North; through Bel Air and Forest Hill to Rocks State Park; then left on Rocks Chrome Hill Road (past the Park Ranger Station to first right -- Knopp Road. Go approximately ½ mile to Camp Wo-Me-To (on right side of road).

From Delaware and North

I-95 South towards Baltimore to Exit 85, Route 22. Continue on Route 22 to Bel Air. Take Route 924 North through Forest Hill to Rocks State Park; left on Rocks Chrome Hill Road to first right -- Knopp Road. Go approximately ½ mile to Camp Wo-Me-To (on right side of road).



CAMP WO-ME-TO comprises nearly 150 acres of hills and woodlands in Harford County, Maryland approximately 25 miles north of Baltimore.



The site borders Rocks State Park and is secluded from the main highways.
