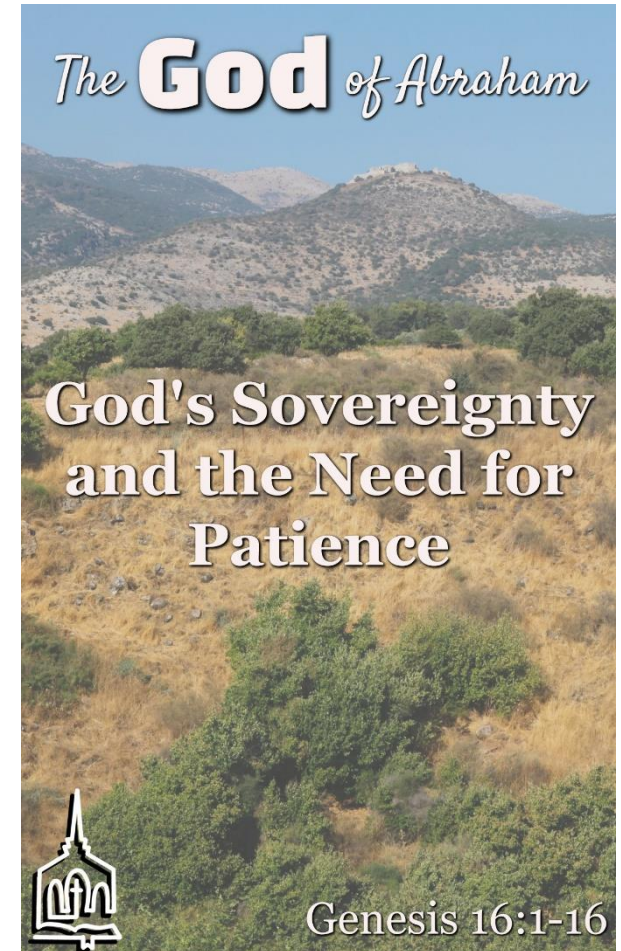

Guidelines for Gathering:
