Ready to Be Baptized?

Are you ready to commit your life to Jesus and publicly announce your faith? Jesus commands water baptism as the way to do this (Matthew 28:19). How can you know if you should be baptized? Ask yourself four questions:

- (1.) **GOD and SIN.** Do you believe in the holy and all-powerful God of the Bible? Do you know what sin is: Our personal offenses against him by living our own way?
- (2.) **THE GOSPEL.** Do you believe the gospel: that Jesus is God and man, lived a perfect life, died in the place of sinners to take their punishment, and rose again to eternal life?
- (3.) **FAITH.** Do you know that you are a sinner, and do you trust Jesus from your heart that he died for YOUR sins and is YOUR Savior? If so, that is called faith.
- (4.) **REPENTANCE.** Have you begun to turn away from a life of selfishness and sin in order to live in obedience and service to Jesus? If so, that is called repentance.

1. I believe God is the Creator of my life:

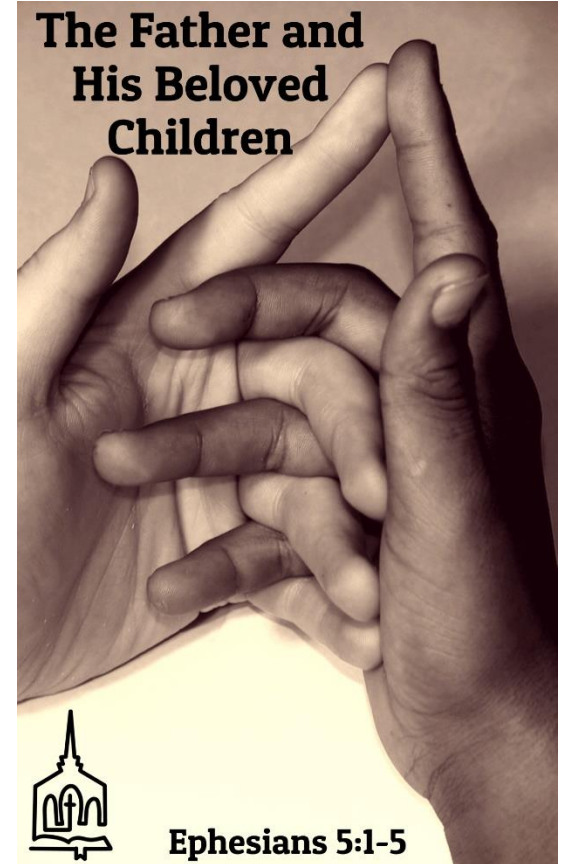
