Saving Faith

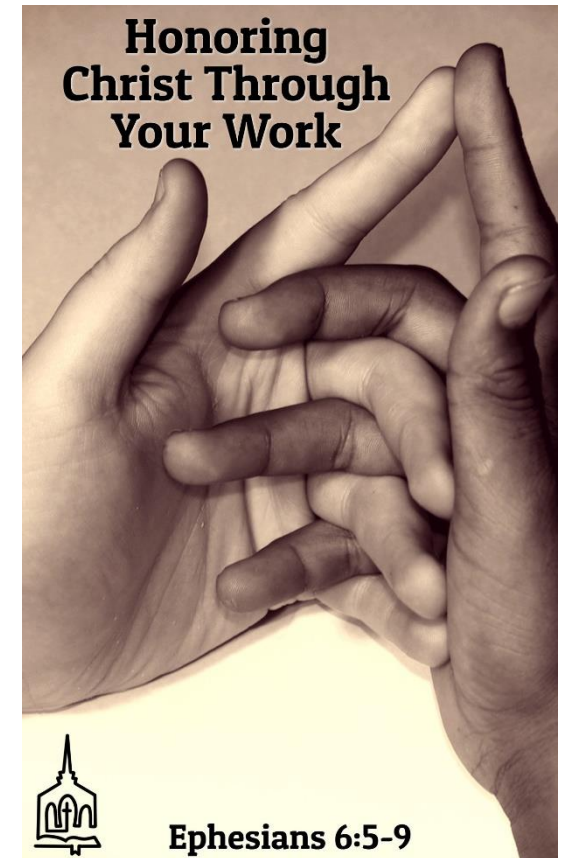
- 1. I believe God is the Creator of my life:**
