Saving Faith

1. I believe God is the Creator of my life:

Acts 17:25 He...gives to all people life and breath and all things

2. I believe God is to be obeyed and has the right to punish those who disobey

Romans 1:18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men.

3. I believe I have disobeyed God and deserve His punishment:

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of glory of God,

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death.....

4. I believe there is nothing I can offer to erase my sin and earn a place in heaven:

Romans 6:23...the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

5. I believe God, by sending His Son Jesus to the cross, has provided the way for my sin to be forgiven.:

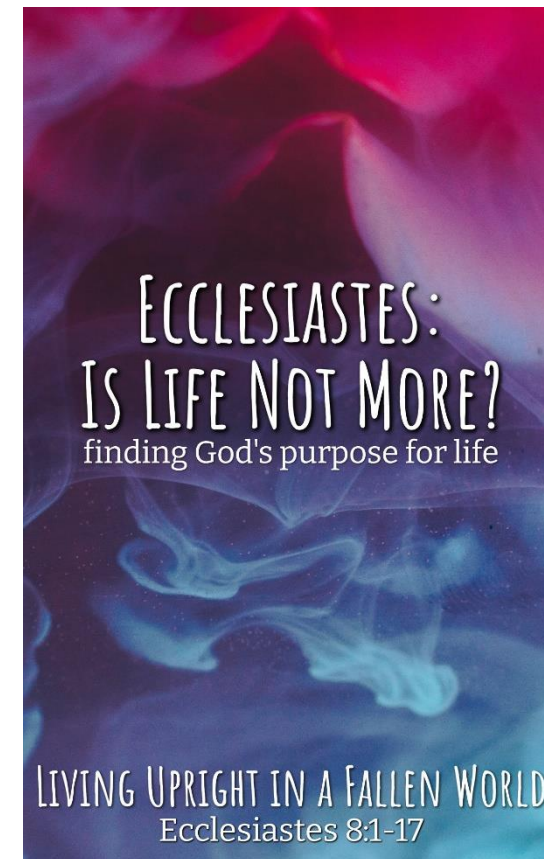
